About Susan:

Susan Perry has been involved in dog training for more than 15 years. She started out in competitive obedience earning among other titles, a Utility title on her Beagle mix, Callie. She soon added agility to her obedience training and agility became her passion. Callie and Susan earned four NADAC Agility Trial Champion titles, an ASCA ATCH and the USDAA APD title. They competed in five NADAC Championships and placed every year including a first place finish in her class in the 2000 Championships.

Susan's current dogs are 3 Australian Shepherds – Lacey, Harley and the new dog – Chevy. Together with Callie, Susan's dogs have earned over 20 NADAC NATCHes and many Versatility NATCHes. Callie, Lacey and Harley have competed at the NADAC Championships several times, placing several times and winning the big trophy many times!

In 2006 Susan won **BOTH** the 20+ Grand Champion award with Lacey **AND** the 20 inch with Harley. To date Lacey is the **ONLY dog EVER** to win the coveted NADAC Versatility Champion Award!

In addition to competing in NADAC, Susan, Lacey and Harley have competed in several other Agility venues including USDAA, CPE and AAC.

In 2001 Susan started her own agility-training center—Blue Lightning Agility Sport Training (BLAST) in Gig Harbor, WA. She teaches all levels of agility classes and gives private agility lessons. She also gives seminars locally as well as around the country and in Canada. Susan is a NADAC judge and a member of Rainier Agility Team.

About the Seminar:

Friday will be for Novice/Open dogs. We will work on Foundation work in the morning. The afternoon will focus on handling, with work on the various crosses needed to successfully negotiate an agility course.

Thursday will be for Elite level dogs. We will cover Distance Foundation work in the morning and learn how to apply it to a course in the afternoon.
